TIPPING POINT IMPACT

THE NEED: Trauma strikes children in poverty at 4 times the rate of their wealthier peers. Adversity in childhood leads to higher risk of cancer, heart disease and mental illness later in life.

OUR IMPACT:

- Tipping Point supported the birth of 887 healthy babies
- 2,076 low-income mothers developed healthy bonds with their babies

SPOTLIGHT ON: NURSE-FAMILY PARTNERSHIP

Children living in poverty are less prepared for school than children from middle-income homes. 1 in 2 are below basic level in reading and math.

Children supported by Nurse-Family Partnership are more likely to be ready for school, and show 50% fewer language delays than expected by age 2.
